

THE OLDENBURG FREUDENFEST SCHOLARSHIP

Award Parameters:

- Write an essay of no less than 250 words and no more than 500 words detailing the volunteer work done and/or are doing now. Include in the essay how volunteer work has changed their life and how they feel about the volunteer work that they do.
- Provide a brief listing of volunteer work including time involved and references for the volunteer work.
- Scholarship is for tuition only and check will be issued directly to the school designated for the students awarded the scholarship.
- Applicable for current Freshmen, Sophomores and Juniors. (In-coming Freshmen are not eligible.)
- Winners of the scholarship are expected to be present Saturday of the Freudenfest.
- Scholarship awarded is not automatically renewable and students must reapply if they are interested in this scholarship for a second or third year.

Selection Process:

- Essays submitted to Oldenburg Academy's Guidance Office.
- Essays will be numbered and the student name kept confidential. Only the Guidance Office will know which student is assigned what number.
- Essays submitted to a member of the Freudenfest Committee.
- Selection committee makes determination.
- Selection committee notifies Guidance Office of students being awarded the scholarship.
- Scholarships are awarded during the Academy's Award Assembly.

Selection Committee:

- Members of the Freudenfest Committee

Presentation Instructions:

- Members of the Freudenfest request that they present the scholarships during the Academy's Award assembly.

Gift Limitations:

Amount and number of students awarded the scholarship will vary year to year based on Freudenfest income.
