



What if I've already registered?

If you have already registered for an ACT test, you can use this code to receive \$5 off an ACT test registration for the February, April, June, or July 2024 test dates.

The voucher code must be redeemed by the time the extended February ACT registration closes on January 22 at 11:59 p.m. CT.

The St. Elizabeth Vision Scholarship application is open for 2024. The deadline for high school seniors who will be pursuing healthcare related education is 1.26.24. Details below:

St. Elizabeth Healthcare's Vision Scholarship Program is now accepting applications for its 2024 scholarship program. This \$2,000 scholarship is available to high school seniors pursuing a degree in the healthcare field: including public health, biochemistry, nursing, medicine, behavioral, occupational health, environmental health, quality, safety, or other health-related disciplines.

The deadline to apply is 5 p.m. on Friday, January 26, 2024. Students interested in applying can fill out this application form: St. Elizabeth Healthcare Scholarship Application Form (jotform.com). The scholarship is open to high school seniors attending schools in Northern Kentucky and Southeastern Indiana.

Scholarship awardees will be notified on February 29, 2024. If selected, you will be asked for documentation to support the data you provide. Awardees will be

recognized at the NKY Excellence in Education Celebration on April 23rd.
