

Steve Coppel, Son of Holocaust Survivors, visits the Sophomore Class

On Friday, January 26, the day before Holocaust Remembrance Day, the sophomore class heard from speaker Steve Coppel from Cincinnati's Holocaust and Humanity Center. Coppel is the son of two Holocaust survivors and he currently volunteers at the Holocaust Center. Sophomores are currently reading Night, the memoir of Holocaust survivor Elie Wiesel. Coppel's father met Wiesel, and Coppel himself met Wiesel's son. Coppel shared his story and encouraged students to be upstanders, not bystanders, when they see injustices today.

Coppel is shown wearing the prayer shawl that his father buried in a grave before being sent to Auschwitz. His father later returned to the site to dig up the religious articles that he buried. Coppel kept the shawl, and his prayer books were donated to the Center).

ACT/SAT Testing Opportunities for OA Students

Each year, Oldenburg Academy provides the opportunity for students to take the ACT and/or the SAT during a school day in an effort to allow students a familiar and comfortable setting in which to take these high stakes exams.

Here are a few details about the exams:

ACT | Oldenburg Academy will offer the ACT to sophomores and juniors on Tuesday, April 9 in the morning. The ACT is an optional test. Students must complete the following form by **Wednesday**, **2/14** if they would like to participate in testing: https://forms.gle/kxUj6MQUMksWnkqAA

The cost of the ACT is \$53.00 which will be billed to student accounts through the business office.

SAT | All juniors will take the SAT on Tuesday, March 5 in the morning. The Indiana State Department of Education requires each junior to participate in this testing. This exam is a graduation qualifying exam, so attendance on test day is important.
