





ACT/SAT Testing Opportunities for OA Students

Each year, Oldenburg Academy provides the opportunity for students to take the ACT and/or the SAT during a school day in an effort to allow students a familiar and comfortable setting in which to take these high stakes exams.

Here are a few details about the exams:

ACT | Oldenburg Academy will offer the ACT to sophomores and juniors on Tuesday, April 9 in the morning. The ACT is an optional test. Students must complete the following form by **Wednesday**, **2/14** if they would like to participate in testing: <u>https://forms.gle/kxUj6MQUMksWnkqAA</u>

The cost of the ACT is \$53.00 which will be billed to student accounts through the business office.

SAT | All juniors will take the SAT on Tuesday, March 5 in the morning. The Indiana State Department of Education requires each junior to participate in this testing. This exam is a graduation qualifying exam, so attendance on test day is important.


