


Dean showed students ancient architecture, including monuments such as Stonehenge and Fort Ancient, were built to help the ancients note the change of seasons based on the sun. Students were in awe of how technical

these buildings were, given the time period in which they were built. We were also reminded how small we really are in the big spectrum of things.


