

OA Faculty Members Receive Award at an Entrepreneurship Conference

Mr. Jason Walke, Entrepreneurship teacher attended a conference in Scottsburg on Tuesday that was run by the Indiana Economic Development Commission. A number of entrepreneurship support organizations were in attendance to learn about new ways that the state of Indiana is helping to support new entrepreneurs. This culminated with a new grant opportunity that all attending organizations were encouraged to apply. Tables set up by geographic location were asked to pitch an idea for a program that they could start in their region to use to apply for these grant dollars. Peer voting was done for the best program idea and Mr. Walke, Amy Streator with the Ripley County Community Foundation and Clarice Patterson with Genesis Pathways were selected as the winners with the idea of the new D.I.C.E. Challenge. This challenge will be a business pitch competition for schools throughout Southeastern Indiana to participate in with cash prizes used to help the top teams convert their ideas to reality. \$500 was awarded to Mr. Walke, Mrs. Streator and Ms. Patterson for their program pitch.
